

# KDTFL Protocols

It is important that all players and spectators follow the guidelines set out by the provincial government, Queen's and KDTFL.

## Players

1. You must be wearing a mask when you enter the facility to check in to play.
2. Please only show up 10 mins before your scheduled game. Have your gear on ready to go. Your warm-up will be quick.
3. When lining up, please be THREE meters apart.
4. Here is the screening tool. <https://covid-19.ontario.ca/screening/worker/>
5. IF you do not have a phone to show the Green check mark from the online screener, you will be asked the questions at the table before being allowed in.
6. You must answer the Covid-19 screening questions prior to showing up to the screening table (no less than 2 hours) and have the green check mark with the date on it to show the KDTFL staff member working the table. NO green check mark, no entry to the facility. Hand sanitizer must be applied to your hands before entering the facility as well. BE patient with the line-up.
7. Once to your team bench, your mask can be removed, if you are comfortable. Players are to be 3 meters apart as per the guidelines for sport, gym facilities etc.
8. Officials will call captains right away. Once to your benches.
9. You will only have a few minutes to warm up. Once the game starts, we ask that you leave the officials bean bags on the ground. The officials will retrieve the bean bags after every play.
10. Once your game has finished, there is no hand shaking of the other team or your team. Captains or coaches are to ensure that all players have used hand sanitizer provided after the game before leaving the field.
11. Hand sanitizer will be at both benches, when needed.
12. When leaving the field, masks MUST be worn out of the facility.
13. After each game, flags will need to be wiped down with Lysol wipes that will be provided after every game, unless KDTFL secures enough for each team.
14. If a player is showing symptoms related to COVID-19 -**What to do**: Do **not** participate in any activity if you are feeling sick or directed by the screening tool to stay home/self-isolate. If the player is at the field in question, they will need to leave the facility and self-isolate until a Covid 19 test is completed and the results are negative, and possibly self-isolate for 14 days depending upon the results. If a player is showing symptoms while playing, the game will be stopped, player will be asked to leave the facility with their belongings and asked to self-isolate until a Covid-19 test can be scheduled. The player would let KFL&A know that you were playing Touch Football. KDTFL then would provide all names associated with that player for close contact.
15. Queen's is a SMOKE FREE Environment. Smoking is prohibited in all areas of the campus and Richardson stadium, Mik-Mac facilities. If one of our players/officials associated with our league is caught smoking on the premises, we as a league could lose the right to use Queen's facilities and face fines associated with smoking.

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### Spectators:

1. No spectators are allowed inside the facility. This means young children as well. Please ensure that you have someone to watch over your children when they are accompanying you to the game.
2. You and your team are responsible for your teams' spectators.
3. If spectators are within two meters of the KDTFL table, they will be asked the Covid Screening questions and their full name and phone number will be required.
4. Queen's has designated areas for spectators. This is for all users of their facility. Behind the Endzones or East side of sidelines.
